

Schoolwide Screening

Screening data is one consideration regarding students' progress teachers discuss during PLC meetings to determine how to meet individual student needs – both the needs of students who do not have the necessary skills and those who are already proficient. See Assessment Calendar.

Screening assessments serve three purposes:

1. Monitor academic progress. Students below benchmarks are identified for further assessments.
 2. Help set a baseline for school goal setting purposes.
 3. Provide data on school programming effectiveness.
- Kindergarten – Grade 8:
 - All students are screened (reading and math) three times per year using STAR.
 - Grades 9 – 12:
 - All 9th grade students are screened (reading and math) in the fall, winter, and spring.
 - All 10th grade students are screened in reading and math in the fall, winter, and spring.
 - All 11th grade students are screened in math in the fall.
